

ADDENDUM Teaching and Examination Rules FSE 2019-2020

Version 12 May 2020

Due to the Corona-crisis the Faculty Board has decided to determine several temporary adjustments to the TER. Alterations of the TER during the Academic Year are only allowed if this is for the benefit of students. The Faculty Board believes these adjustments help students to proceed with their studies as conveniently as possible. This addendum contains the temporary provisions for Academic Year 2019-2020.

BSc & MSc Teaching and Examination Rules 2019-2020

Assessment period

The Faculty Board has decided to prolong the assessment period of 2b. Please find below the new schedule for assessment periode 2b. The scheduling of the assessments will be available on the 29th of May the latest.

Assessment method

The method of assessment is prescribed in Ocasys. Apart from the location (at home, instead of in the university buildings) the assessment methods for most courses have not been altered. For some courses, alterations in the assessment methods have been made, e.g. an assignment or an oral exam instead of a practical or a written exam. These alterations have been made on request of the examiner, in close cooperation with the deputy programme director, and have been approved by the Board of Examiners. Students are informed of these alterations by the examiner through Nestor.

BSA-policy

First year BSc-students need to obtain a minimum of 45 ECTS in order to continue their studies. If they have insufficient progress which can not be linked to extraordinary personal circumstances, students receive a Binding Study Advice (BSA).

In 2019-2020 this BSA-policy will not be executed as usual. Students will not receive a BSA if they have failed to pass the threshold. Students will still receive a positive study advice if they obtained a minimum of 45 ECTS.
